When you arrive at the Schoolhouse, Mutianyu, you are immediately welcomed by Jim, his family and staff. I recommend turning left at the top and heading toward Jinkou which is both quieter and more spectacular. After our walk we went for a late lunch at the Schoolhouse restaurant. I ate lamb curry and my husband had spaghetti bolognese, both were delicious, followed by some fantastic homemade ice cream. The accommodation includes breakfast, which is not to be missed! A full English and continental combined. I could not recommend this venue more highly. We had the good fortune to stay at a Schoolhouse property and eat at the restaurant.
